

**4. AGE: -** The age limit shall be determined for the under mentioned posts as on **10/04/2026**:

Post Code	Age limit
5/26, 6/26, 7/26, 8/26 & 9/26	18-22 years
10/26 to 11/26	18-32 years

Category	Age Relaxation
APST	Relaxable upto 05 (five) years.
Ex-Servicemen	Every Ex-Servicemen who has put in not less than 6 months continuous service in the Armed Forces of the Union shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from his actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post or service for which he seeks appointment by more than 3 years, he shall be deemed to satisfy the condition regarding age limit.

- An 'Ex-Serviceman (Ex-SM)' means a person who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the Regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union.

**NOTE:**

4.1. As per the NOTIFICATION vide No.HOME-11011 (13)/57/2025/9941, Dated 05<sup>th</sup> September 2025, ONE- TIME RELAXATION of the Upper Age Limit as one time measure will be granted to those candidates who had appeared in the written examination dated 13/07/2025 vide Advertisement No.09/2020 for the post codes 65/20 [Constable (GD) Civil Police Male], 66/20 [Constable (GD) Civil Police Female] & 67/20 [Constable IRBn (Band/ Bugler)] conducted by the Arunachal Pradesh Staff Selection Board in respect of Constable (Civil Police, Arunachal Armed Police Battalion, Indian Reserved Battalion) to enable them to appear for the vacancies for the posts of Constables in the said examination.

4.2. A separate annexure with the name of the candidates those had appeared in the written examination dated 13/07/2025 will be uploaded in the website in due course.

4.3. Accordingly, the ONE TIME AGE RELAXATION is restricted to Post Code 5/26 [Constable Band (IRBn)], 6/26 [Constable Bugler (IRBn)], 8/26 [Constable Civil Police (Female)] and 9/26 [Constable Civil Police (Male)] of the instant advertisement. The relaxation will not be applicable for Post Code 7/26, 10/26 and 11/26.

**5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-**

- The candidate must be a citizen of India.
- The educational qualification, age, experience as stipulated in the advertisement shall be determined as on the closing date of submission of application i.e., on dated **10.04.2026**.

**6. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION:-**

The scheme of examination will consist of 3 stages (Stage-I, Stage-II & Stage-III) for Post Code-5/26 to 10/26 and Stage-I & Stage-II for Post Code- 11/26.

## 6.1. Stage- I: Objective Type Multiple Choice Questions

## 6.2. Syllabus:

Constable Band (IRBn) (5/26), Constable Bugler (IRBn) (6/26), Constable IRBn (7/26), Constable Civil Police (Female) (8/26), Constable Civil Police (Male) (9/26), Fireman (10/26) & Special Tiger Guard (STPF) (11/26),

### (a) General Awareness – 50 marks (25 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus: - Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations /Institutions, etc. State Specific questions may also be asked.

### (b) General Intelligence & Reasoning Ability - 50 marks (25 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus: -The syllabus of General Intelligence & Reasoning Ability includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

### (c) Arithmetical & Numerical Ability – 50 marks (25 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus: - The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover Number Systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Data Interpretation, Fractions, L.C.M, H.C.F, Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs.

### (d) Test of English Language and Comprehension – 50 marks (25 questions of 2 marks each)

Syllabus: - Questions in this component will be designed to test the candidate's understanding and knowledge of English Language and will be based on spot the error, fill in the blanks, synonyms, antonyms, spelling/ detecting misspelled words, idioms & phrases, one word substitution, improvement of sentences, active/ passive voice of verbs, conversion into direct/ indirect narration, shuffling of sentence parts, shuffling of sentences in a passage, cloze passage & comprehension passage.

## NOTE:

- 6.2.1. A candidate must secure a minimum of 33% or more marks in aggregate in the written examination paper. Candidates securing less than 33% of marks in aggregate shall be deemed not eligible for selection. There is no negative marking.

**6.3. Stage-II: Physical Standard Test (PST), Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Trade Test**

- i. The candidates for all **post codes 5/26 to 11/26** will have to qualify PST and PET as mentioned against each post code of this advertisement.
- ii. The candidates for post code 5/26 & 6/26 will have to qualify Trade Test
- iii. **The total number of candidates shortlisted for stage-II (PST, PET & Trade Test) will be in 1:3 ratio subject to the candidates securing a minimum of 33% marks in aggregate in the written examination paper.**
- iv. The Ex-Servicemen candidates are exempted from appearing the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) and Trade Test. However, they will have to appear and qualify the Physical Standard Test (PST).

**6.4. Stage-III: Medical Fitness Test**

- i. The candidates for **post codes 5/26 to 10/26** will also have to qualify the medical fitness test as mentioned against each post code of this advertisement.

**NOTE:**

**6.4.1. Stage-II (PST, PET & Trade Test) and Stage-III (Medical Fitness Test) shall be qualifying in nature only.**

**6.4.2. The final merit shall be prepared on the basis of merit-cum-preference in objective type written examination only.**

**6.4.3. Other details, if any, will be informed through the official website.**

  - iv. APST Certificate (if applicable).
  - v. Intimation letter to HoD for those who are in regular Govt. Service.
  - vi. Discharge book and Pay and Pension Order (PPO) issued by the competent authority for Ex-Servicemen.
  - vii. Admit Card and printout of online application form.
  - viii. Any other documents as may be relevant.
- The shortlisted candidates will be required to submit legible self-attested copies of the documents and Admit Card at the time of verification of documents (*any information contained in the attached certificates shall not be considered unless it is claimed in the application form*).
  - **Shortlisted candidates will have to upload copies of the above-mentioned documents on the APSSB portal when notified to do so. The candidates will also have to produce the above-mentioned Certificates/ Documents and mark sheet, both in original and photocopies, during document verification, failing which his/her candidature will be summarily rejected and the final merit list shall be prepared excluding such candidates who failed to produce required documents during the verification process. Candidates may duly take note that no additional time shall be given for the production of documents.**

- 8.1. There is no provision for re-evaluation /re-checking of Answer Sheet /Answer Scripts in respect of the examinations conducted by APSSB.
- 8.2. The APSSB reserves the right to cancel/withdraw any question/questions from the Test.
- 8.3. The Board makes the provisional selection of the candidates on the basis of information provided in the application and documents/certificates provided by the candidate at the time of submission of documents and recommends the same to the indenting/ user department. Further, the Appointing Authority i.e., the indenting/user department verifies and satisfies itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates and eligibility as per the Recruitment Rules before finally appointing the candidate(s). Therefore, the provisional selection of a candidate does not confer upon him/her any right of appointment unless the Appointing Authority is satisfied, after such inquiry as may be considered necessary, that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the post.
